ALL: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and the Holy Spirit, Amen

THE ANGELUS

The Angel of the Lord declared to Mary. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus.

Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Behold the handmaid of the Lord: Be it done unto me according to your word. Hail Mary . . .

(All take turn to recite the following prayers).

- 03: Lord, who taught us to proclaim the Gospel to the poor; bless us to live according to the Gospel / and become witnesses to your truth. We pray to the Lord.
- 04: Lord, bless our nation with missionaries / who may sacrifice their lives with You as St. Thomas, the Father of our faith. We pray to the Lord.
- 05: Lord, bless those who are working at various walks of life / to become missionaries of love and service / through the gift of the Holy Spirit, we pray to the Lord.
- 06: Lord, send forth your Holy Spirit / to strengthen those who are distressed / that they may offer their lives of suffering / along with your sacrifice. We pray to the Lord.
- 07: Give the strength to Your Church, that You have redeemed with Your holy blood / and promoted with the blood of the martyrs, to overcome difficulties and oppositions / and to execute its mission successfully. We pray to the Lord.

- 08: Give your people the goodwill / to think with the Church / and take part in its activities / to the best of their ability. We pray to the Lord.
- 09: Promote understanding and unity / among the various Churches / and strengthen them in the only true faith. We pray to the Lord.
- 10: Lord, respecting the law and the prophets, You have completed all the precepts. Give us the courage to see You in our superiors / and to obey their orders, we pray to the Lord.
- 11: Help us minister to You all our lives / with the zeal of Elijah / and the bravery of Moses, we pray to the Lord.
- 12: Lord, You transfigured Yourself at the Mount of Tabor / and counseled Your disciples who got scared. Make us worthy to receive You with joy / when You appear in glory / on the day of the last judgment, we pray to the Lord.
- 13: Lord, teach our political leaders / to give up violence / and lead the world in love and tolerance / in the way of peace, we pray to the Lord.
- 14: Lord our hope and resurrection, make us worthy to line up on Your right side / on the day You appear in glory / in the skies with the sign of the cross, we pray:
- 15: That all our brethren who passed away / in the hope of resurrection / may be made worthy to take part / in the glory of Jesus Christ's resurrection, we pray:
- 16: That our brethren / who were nourished by the Body and Blood of Christ / and who embraced the eternal sleep of death / may be given eternal life, we pray:
- 17: That we may be given the grace / to rise at the last judgment day / with a radiance excelling that of the sun, we pray:
- 18: That we may be enabled to arrive at the heavenly joy / that has been prepared for the just / from the beginning of the world, we pray:
- 19: Let us commend ourselves and one another / to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- ALL: Lord, Our God, we commend ourselves to You.

LEADER: Lord, who sent your Holy Spirit / to fill the apostles with the Spirit of the Holy Gospel, bless this congregation / with the gifts of Your Holy Spirit / so that we all may bear witness to You as missionaries. Bless us to grow in mutual love and unity, and to live a life proper to your followers.

On the ten small beads of each decade, say:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion,

Have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Conclude with:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (Say 3 Times).
